The main objective of the External Academic and Administrative Audit is to review, assess and evaluate the performance in domains of teaching-learning and evaluation process, research, extra-curricular and administrative aspects pertaining to Academic School and Administrative Departments of Tamil Nadu Open University to ensure preparedness for National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) accreditation.

The External Academic and Administrative Audit Committee visited different Divisions, Cells/Centres and Academic School / Departments of Tamil Nadu Open University as per the abovementioned Schedule.

In the introductory meeting on 22-02-2023(Wednesday), the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. S.Arumugam welcomed the Convener and the Members of the Committee and briefly presented about the vision and mission of the Tamil Nadu Open University(TNOU) with their planning for NAAC Accreditation process. He also introduced the Registrar, Finance Officer, Controller of Examinations, Chairpersons and the CIQA Team to the EAAA Committee.

The Vice-Chancellor requested the Convener and the Members to peruse the draft Self Study Report (SSR) prepared by TNOU and offer their valuable suggestions. The Vice-Chancellor specially requested Col.Dr.G.Thiruvasagam, (former Vice-Chancellor, University of Madras, Chennai & Bharthiyar University, Coimbatore) who has vast experience in the field of higher education, Prof. Manjulika Srivastava, Director, CIQA, IGNOU and Prof. Swaraj Basu, Professor, IGNOU to provide valuable inputs as the Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi has obtained A++ grade in NAAC.

The External Audit started with presentation of the detailed draft of SSR by Prof. P.Thiyagarajan, Director-CIQA, TNOU that the CIQA Team of TNOU has prepared till date.

The Committee made suggestions and shared their observations regarding all the seven criteria in SSR. After that the CIQA Team asked set of questions for the solutions of queries they had, and the External Audit Committee responded to them positively. Further the External Audit Committee also guided how to prepare seven separate files criterion-wise for the Quantitative Metrics (Q_nM) and Qualitative Metrics (Q_mM) therein. The External Audit Committee also suggested how supportive documents should be uploaded and filed properly with proper numbering.

In the afternoon session 22-02-2023 (Wednesday), the External Audit Committee witnessed and evaluated all the presentations made by Academic Schools/ Departments like Management, Continuing Education, Education, Politics and Public Administration, Social Sciences, Science, Computer Science, Tamil and Cultural studies, Humanities, Library and Information Science, and Journalism and New Media Studies. The Committee members made certain observations and suggestions regarding the design of presentation, structure of presentation and the inputs in the presentation.

The Committee briefed about the 'do' and 'don'ts' of presentation. It was also suggested that all the teaching and non-teaching staff should go through the Open University NAAC current Manual and be familiar with the seven criteria. A Visit to Academic Block was also made and the Committee interacted with the faculty members of School of Management Studies, School of Continuing Education, School of Politics and Public Administration, School of Journalism and New Media Studies, School of Social Sciences, School of Science, School of

Humanities, School of Tamil and Cultural Studies, School of Education, School of Computer Science, School of Library and Information Science, and staff of Student Registration and Evaluation Division, Material Distribution Division, Centre for University Informatics, and also the Central Library, TNOU Guest House and Convocation Hall.

On 23-02-2023 (Thursday), the Second day, the External Audit Committee visited Admission Section, Student Support Service Division, Centre for Internal Quality Assurance, Office of the Vice-Chancellor, Office of the Registrar, Administration Division, Finance Division, various Cells and Centres of the University and Centre for Electronic Media Production and Research. The Committee checked relevant files and registers. The Committee also enquired from the office staff and officers about their nature of work in the University, training/ orientation to the ODL system, their performance, their future plans, and coordination with statutory bodies and authorities. The Committee also interacted with the other stakeholders. Further the Committee guided department/division heads, members of respective department/division for their preparation for the NAAC Peer Team visit. The Committee responded to the queries raised by the staff.

The Committee enquired about the file management system, automation, policy for promotion of Research, Consultancy, Employee welfare, Self Learning Materials, Mobilization and Optimization of Resources, and also Exam Manuals, Online Admission Manual, Regional Centre Manual and Academic Planner.

Exit meeting was arranged wherein the Committee highlighted the strengths of the University i.e., the efforts made to reach out to the rural and tribal populations of the State of Tamil Nadu and the Community engagement programmes towards the goal of making inclusive society. The use of ICT in providing learner support starting from admission to declaration of results; and the teaching-learning and evaluation process of the University is highly commendable. TNOU is doing appreciable work in promoting value-based education through Tamil language and its rich cultural heritage. In line with NEP 2020, TNOU has taken various initiatives for promotion of flexible education and application of multiple entry and exit, credit transfer, multidisciplinary academic programmes.

The Committee also appreciated the efforts made by the present Vice-Chancellor, Registrar, Director, CIQA and his team members and the convenors of the seven Criteria in preparing the SSR.

The Committee also felt that the University should try to increase the enrollment in various academic programmes, make efforts to develop academic programmes taking into consideration the diverse learners' needs, introduce online programmes as per UGC regulations, prepare MOOCs for SWAYAM platform, adopt available MOOCs of other HEIs.

The Committee also drew the attention for better maintenance of the campus with a focus on clean, green and energy efficient campus.

The Registrar of TNOU thanked the Convener and the Members of the External Academic and Administrative Audit Committee for accepting the invitation and providing valuable inputs.




